67 years ago, on February 17th, 1941 the Rosary Credit Union, GVC Credit Union as we know it today, held its first official Annual General Meeting. The meeting was held at the Rosary Hall and had 26 members in attendance.

Operation reports for the year 1940 showed cash on hand of \$211.29; assets totaling \$797.77; approved loans totaling \$415.00; and 52 members in all.

2006 Financial Results

During 2006, assets increased by \$10.9 million or 7.7% to reach \$152.0 million at year end.

Net earnings after the payment of dividends on Equity Shares and a \$44,736 patronage dividend were \$468,543. Our net earnings were added to retained earnings, which brought them to \$5.792 million, up 8.8% from 2005.

Overall, our credit union enjoyed a strong year in 2006 and our overall capital position was well in excess of the regulated required levels.

Copies of the audited financial statements are available from our branch managers and will be discussed at our May 2nd, 2007 Annual General Meeting.


